



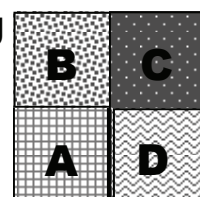
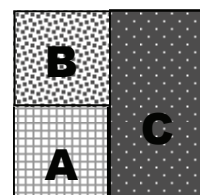
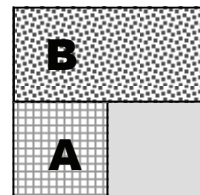
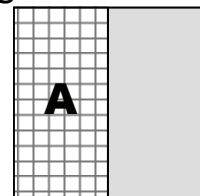
# Quick & Easy Coaster

4-1/2" square coaster

For each coaster you need:  
1/4 yard fabric or  
(5) 5" square scraps  
5" square batting

## Instructions:

1. Use a rotary cutter and ruler to cut (5) 5" squares.
2. Select (4) squares and fold them in half with wrong sides together. Press along fold.
3. Place the unfolded square on top of the batting with the right side facing up.
4. With fold sides to the inside, place the folded rectangles on top of the square, as shown. Place the first rectangle (A) on the left-hand side.
5. Place the second rectangle (B) across the top, covering the top half of the first rectangle.
6. Place the third rectangle (C) along the right-hand side, covering the right half of the second rectangle.
7. Place the fourth rectangle (D) along the bottom edge, covering the bottom half of the third rectangle and tucking it UNDER the bottom half of the first rectangle. The finished square will look like a closed box top with the edges neatly tucked. Stitch 1/4" seam around all sides.
8. Trim corners. To finish the coaster, reach inside the woven rectangles to turn the coaster right side out.
9. (Optional) Top stitch around the coaster.



*Note: you can change the size of your coaster by changing the size of your squares (4"-5"-6"-7").*
